Thanks for being willing to take us on a tour of your supervised visitation program!

We invite you to show us your center as if we were the parents and children coming to use your program. Be sure to highlight any specific safety and security measures you have in place to support adult and child survivors. For example, show us if you have cameras or a special type of door and any unique way you have designed your space to support parents and children's physical and emotional safety. We know that not all sites are the same and that many of you have had to be creative. Please share the many ways you have been creative in adapting your space.

For your video, please record horizontally if possible! You may need to turn off the portrait orientation lock on your phone if you are recording on that device.

Below are some of the aspects of your site we would love to see on our visit:

- 1. Where each person parks, arrives, and departs, highlighting what is in place to support adult and child survivors' safety.
- 2. Waiting and check-in spaces. Be sure to share how these spaces are used, and give examples of what you do with parents and children during orientations and check-ins.
- 3. Visitation rooms and other spaces where families spend time together. Be sure to highlight any items, activities, or unique aspects of these spaces—for example, if you have a place where parents and children share a meal, make crafts, or play a game.
- 4. Share how you make your space accessible to all families and all abilities.
- 5. Staff spaces (meeting rooms, offices, debrief space)
- 6. Highlight 2-3 aspects of your program that you are most proud of. This can be about your site design, approach to services, community partnerships, survivor support, or any other aspect of your work you want to share.

Once you've recorded your video, please save the file with your program or organization in the file name: "ProgramName_video" is an ideal format. The file type should ideally be .MP4 or .MOV.
